# Living Our Mission and Making a Difference

Poor nutrition causes nearly half (45%) of all deaths in children under five – 3.1 million children each year. In fact, hunger kills more people each year than AIDS, malaria and tuberculosis combined. There is something you can do to change that.

On April 13th and 14th, Bluff Park UMC will join with several other churches, schools, and civic organizations from the Vestavia/Hoover area to pack 250,000 nutritious meals to be sent overseas to relieve hunger. This project will be carried out in conjunction with Stop Hunger Now, an organization dedicated to eradicating world hunger.

Over the course of two days, groups of volunteers will combine rice, soy, dehydrated vegetables, and a flavoring mix that includes 23 essential vitamins and minerals into small, shelf-stable, meal packages. The packaged meals are

shipped throughout the world to support school feeding programs, orphanages and crisis relief.



This is a multi-generational ministry opportunity. During the event, volunteers work in teams at each packaging station. Volunteers also set up and take down packaging stations and equipment, fill bins with raw ingredients, weigh and seal the bags, box the packaged meals, and stack the boxes on pallets, and load the pallets and equipment onto a truck. If you have a heart to serve, there is something available for you to do during this event.



## **How To Get Involved**

We are encouraging Sunday School classes and ministry groups within the church to participate as a group. But, each person must register individually on the website. The meal packaging event takes place at Vestavia Hills UMC, 2061 Kentucky Ave.

This event is one of the easiest ways to make a tangible impact on the lives of people around the world who struggle with access to nutritious food. In addition, it is a wonderful opportunity to gather together as a community, and it is fun.
